

Nā Pua‘a Li‘ili‘i ‘Ekolu – (The Three Little Pigs)

A Hawaiian language play for children adapted from a story from England

CHARACTERS:

- Tūtū - A “grandmotherly” older woman. The storyteller.
Māmā - The mother pig
Keoki - The little pig wearing a hat
Keoni - The little pig wearing sunglasses
Tita - “Sister.” The little pig wearing a lei.
Kāne - The kind man carrying straw, then sticks, then rocks.
‘Ilio hae - The wild dog

(When not on stage, the actors playing Māmā & Kāne serve as musicians for sound effects.)

The English in brackets – [...] is for the benefit of the actors to understand what they are saying in Hawaiian. Those lines are not to be spoken in English.
